Mentioned by Rooke. The pillar, with a pitched top and c.3ft high, remains W of Harlow Wood on the W side of the road to Mansfield. (2)

The Forest Stone, Lyndhurst was the central pillar of the Old Market House in Mansfield where the court of Swainmote was held before the Verderers of Sherwood Forest. The pillar was placed at the spot on the N side of Harlow Wood where the participants in the Swainmote Court met, before the court, to hear those matters affecting the forest which were to come before the court when it sat in Mansfield. (3)

The pillar, known as The Forest Stone, was placed at its present position in 1752. It had formed part of the Med Market or Moot Hall in Mansfield and was used to mark the site presumably because of that building's historical association with the Swainmote Court. It has been restored and a modern inscription added c.1952 but occupies the original site. (4)

Of local sandstone, 2.5m high and 0.5m square with chamfered edges stopped top and bottom. It is set in a base of mortared rubble and surrounded by iron railings. Modern plate in W face with explanation. At the base of the W face are the marks of a former plate (suggests the stone has been erected upside down). There seems to be some doubt as to whether the stone marks the site of the Swainmote Court or of a preliminary assembly but the existence of a Moot Hall in Mansfield favours the latter. (NB ref (1) probably refers to a different stone). (5)

Named 'White Stone'. (7)

Commemorative monument. Erected 1752 by Henrietta Cavendish Holles Harley. (8)
